 5:30 PM Check into **The Woodlands Hotel, A Colonial Williamsburg Hotel**, for 3 nights.  
 6:30 PM Dinner is included tonight.

**Day 2**

- A Deluxe Continental Breakfast is included.  
 9:00 AM We are joined by a Costumed Informative guide for a tour of America's largest living history museum, **Colonial Williamsburg**. From 1699 to 1780, Williamsburg was the political, social and cultural capital of Britain's largest wealthiest and most populous colony. Colonial Williamsburg encompasses more than 500 buildings and 90 acres of magnificent gardens. In the shops, taverns, government buildings, homes and streets George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Patrick Henry, George Mason and other Virginia Patriots debated the ideas - liberty, independence and personal freedoms that led to the founding of American democracy. Interaction with costumed interpreters of varied age, race and social position provides a first-hand view of life when the town was the capitol of the Virginia colony.  
 12 Noon Enjoy lunch & shopping (on own) in Merchant's Square.  
 Located adjacent to Colonial Williamsburg's Historic Area, Merchants Square is an 18th Century style retail village with more than 40 shops & restaurants. The restaurants on Merchant's Square offer choices from a quick sandwich to the freshest seafood, steaks & contemporary American regional cooking. Dinner is included tonight at a local Tavern.

**Day 3**

- A Deluxe Continental Breakfast is included.  
 9:00 AM Depart for **The Jamestown Settlement**.  
 9:30 AM Relive the experience of America's first permanent English colony at this fun outdoor living history museum that brings the 17<sup>th</sup> Century in Virginia to life. Enjoy a short movie (and gallery exhibits) that describes the cultures of the Powhatan Indians, Europeans & Africans who converged in 17<sup>th</sup> Century Virginia and trace Jamestown's beginnings. Climb aboard re-creations of three ships and explore life size re-creations of the colonist's fort & a Powhatan village. Enjoy browsing the museum stores too.  
 12 Noon Lunch is available (on own) in the Jamestown Settlement Café.  
 1:00 PM Depart for **Yorktown Victory Center / The New Revolution Museum**.  
 At the Yorktown Victory Center and take in the Revolution through dynamic gallery exhibits, films & outdoor living history. The new American Revolution Museum tell anew the story of the nation's founding, from the twilight of the colonial period to the dawn of the Constitution and beyond. Exciting new indoor galleries feature period artifacts, interactive exhibits and films including "The Siege of Yorktown", with a 180-degree surround screen & dramatic special effects. Outside witness artillery demonstrations, drill with wooded muskets and a re-created Continental Army encampment. Enjoy free time to explore Riverwalk Landing in Yorktown. Spend some time soaking up the atmosphere of our nation's exciting history while at the same time enjoying modern-day conveniences and eclectic mix of shops!
