Visit a restored apartment at the National Historic Site of 97 Orchard Street's Tenement Building, home to an estimated 7,000 working class immigrants from over 20 nations, between 1863 and 1935. Enjoy a guided tour where you will learn the story about a working-class family who lived there while trying to make a new life for a better future on Manhattan's Lower East Side. Then see the Lower East Side through the eyes of the immigrants who have lived here for 150 years on a guided walking tour of the neighborhood.
