

Mohonk Mountain House



New Paltz, NY

The historic resort is located on the shore of Lake Mohonk, which is half a mile long. The main structure, which was designated a National Historic Landmark in 1986, was built by Quaker twin brothers Albert and Alfred Smiley between 1869 and 1910. The house was given a National Historic Landmark designation in 1986, and a United Nations Environment Programmed Award in 1994 in honor of 125 years of stewardship. According to the National Trust for Historic Preservation, "Through its buildings and roads, its land, and its spirit, Mohonk

exemplifies America's history and culture. Mohonk has since managed to maintain its 19th century character into the 21st century."
