Sunday, September 8

Depart for Rochester, NY. Make meal and rest stops (on own) en route. Today we will make a nice stop for a New York State Wine Tasting. We check into our hotel. Dinner is included tonight.

Monday, September 9

Breakfast is included. Today we visit the Strong Museum in Rochester, home to the largest collection of historical materials relating to play and learning. Exhibits include: America at Play, Aquariums, Dance Lab and more. Visitors rave about this museum! Lunch (on own) today. This afternoon we cross the border to Niagara Falls, Canada and check into our hotel for two nights. Dinner is included in the revolving restaurant at the top of the famous Skylon Tower. Take the exhilarating ride above the Falls & see the spectacular view below.

Tuesday, September 10

Breakfast is included. We are joined by a local guide for a narrated tour of Niagara Falls and the surrounding area. It's a day to bring your camera! Enjoy a spectacular Niagara Falls boat ride on board the Hornblower where we come as close to the falls as we want to be - *A truly unique and safe experience for you to always remember.* Lunch (on own) today. Our tour will include Table Rock, a wonderful observation complex at the brink of Horseshoe Falls, a stop at the famous Floral Clock and Niagara-on-the-Lake, the first capital of Upper Canada. Late afternoon we depart for Toronto, where we will be spending the night with dinner included.

Wednesday, September 11

Breakfast is included. Experience the city first-hand on a narrated city tour and learn about its history. Drive by the Harbourfront and Queen's Quay area where you will visit the top of the CN Tower, the world's tallest free-standing structure, adjacent to the home of the Toronto Blue Jays! See across the harbor to the Toronto Islands, home to full time residents as well Centreville, a popular summer amusement park. We will also be taking a step back in time to a period of European elegance as we visit Casa Loma (Spanish for Hill House). Constructed from 1911 to 1914, this Gothic Revival style mansion and garden in midtown Toronto is Canada's most majestic castle and Toronto's premier historic attraction. Late afternoon, we depart for the 1000 Islands. Here we spend the night with dinner included.

Thursday, September 12

Breakfast is included. This morning we relax on a Two Nations Narrated Boat Ride of the world-famous 1000 Islands, where you will take in miles of picturesque coastlines, castles, and woodlands. There really are a thousand reasons to love it here. Lunch is available (on own). After lunch we head back to the US and the Turning Stone Casino Resort in Verona, NY. Everyone will receive Casino Slot Play and a Dinner Voucher. Good Luck to All!

Friday, September 13

A Breakfast Voucher is included. This morning we depart for Albany and the NY State Museum. This architecturally stunning museum is in the heart of our capitol at the Empire State Plaza established in 1836 the oldest and largest state museum in the country and features: *Fire Engine Hall, New York Metropolis Hall, Native Peoples of New York, World Trade Center Gallery and a new Exhibit for 2018 – Votes for Women (celebrating New York's Suffrage Centennial).* Next, we enjoy beer tasting at the Albany Pump Station. All the beers served are brewed in house with up to 11 brews to choose from, there's something for everyone. You will learn about the brewing process and ingredients in the beers you taste. Lunch included at the Albany Pump Station. From here we head home making a rest stop (on own) en route. Arrive home this evening with fond memories of a beautiful Canadian & New York State trip.
